

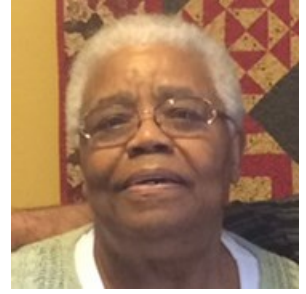

## Lower Your West Virginia Tax Liability!

Did you know that all our services are free of cost? How, you may ask. One way is with the help from a program called, the Neighborhood Investment Program (N-I-P). The following is an example of how this program works. Let's use the example of a \$500 donation. Good Shepherd receives \$500 from your donation. Good Shepherd then gives you back a WV tax credit of \$250 that can be applied to your WV tax liability. The \$500 donation can also be claimed on your federal tax return as a charitable donation. A donations of \$500 cost the donor only \$150 after using the tax credits and federal deductions.
